I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 1 - Trossachs and Teith. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 9,475 and the number of ballot papers received was 5,472 giving a percentage turnout of 57.8%. There were 100 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,344.
