I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 2 - Keith and Cullen. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 8,102 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,490 giving a percentage turnout of 43.1%. There were 58 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 859.

The number of first preference votes for each of the candidates was:
